“NARS Person of the Year Award”

The North American Rail Shippers Association, if approved by the Awards Committee, has the option to present an award for outstanding contributions to NARS AND its Regional Association(s) during the past one to two years. The award will be presented at the next Annual Meeting for the year in which award is given.

Criteria for NARS Person of the Year Award will include the following:

- 1) Individuals must be nominated by a Regional Association**
 - a) Regional Associations may only nominate one person.**
 - b) Nominations are good for one (1) year only.**
 - c) Regional Associations may nominate individuals for subsequent years after original nomination.**
- 2) At time of nomination, the nominee must be a member or associate member of one of the five regional associations that make up the North American Rail Shipper Association.**
- 3) Nominees should possess the following:**
 - a) Involvement with a Regional Association during the past one to two years**
 - b) Involvement with the North American Rail Shippers Association during the past one to two years**
 - c) Good character**
 - d) Responsible position in the Rail Industry**
- 4) Regional Association should give a descriptive account of:**
 - a) Nominees’ involvement with the regional association**
 - b) Nominees’ involvement with the North American Rail Shippers Association**
- 5) Recipients of the award will receive the following:**
 - a) Recognition plaque**
 - b) Roundtrip airfare and up to three (3) nights lodging for recipient and guest.**
